October Art Demonstrator: Cindy Lommasson



Cindy Lommasson is an Asian-influenced painter and art instructor in Portland.

She strives to distill a subject to its simplest expression, where a

single well-executed brush stroke, with ink, can communicate volumes. Minimal color accompanying the ink painting allows it to retain its essential qualities, emphasizing line and shape. The Dream Journey Painters, who created imaginary nature scenes in seclusion during turbulent 4th century China, are a favorite influence on her landscape paintings.

Lommasson graduated from Portland State University in 1984 with a B.A. in Art, with an emphasis in ceramics. Pottery from China and Japan greatly inspired her work in clay. Later, she began exploring ink painting and calligraphy from the same two cultures. Since 2003, Chinese brush painting has provided the foundation of her artistic expression. Her style has evolved from a traditional base toward a more contemporary, abstracted vision, while continuing to use many of the time-honored materials: Chinese paper, sumi ink, and watercolor.

She is the recipient of a 2011 Regional Arts and Culture Council Professional Development Grant, and an active

member and workshop instructor at the Oregon Society of Artists.

Treasurer Linda Whittingham, announced a balance of \$13,032.41 in all accounts. She also reminded members that membership dues of \$35 are now due. After this September meeting, renewal dues will increase to \$40.

November 16 and 17 Members Only Fall Show information:

On-line registration for the Fall Show will open on October 1. Entry fees are \$20 for the first entry and \$5 each for the second and third entries. See the Prospectus for oversize art information.

Elaine Pawski will be the Artist Bazaar director. The bazaar is a new idea and will give members an opportunity to sell items such a cards, unframed prints and other fine art items they have created. There is a \$5.00 fee to participate in the bazaar and each member may submit up to 20 items. An inventory list of items for sale is to be sent to Elaine by November 11th. Cards, unframed prints and other similar items are to be placed in clear plastic sleeves. Knitted or crotched items or items one would find at a craft sale will not be accepted.

A reception for artists, honoring show winners, will be on Saturday from 11 am to 1 pm and will feature a continental brunch.

- Registration must be completed and paid by November 11, 2019
- Original work only. Execution of artwork shall be solely that of the artist. No work copied from old masters or from copyrighted or published materials without permission. No work produced in step-by-step instruction classes.
- ☐ Art must not have been previously entered in a SWA show. *Please check your records*.
- ☐ Art must be appropriate for family viewing.
- □ 2D and 3D art welcomed (no jewelry or furniture please).

Show managers reserve the right to determine whether art meets the prospectus requirements.

Art will not be separated by medium/category for judging.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Number of Pieces: SWA artists may enter up to 3 entries.

Fees: \$20 first entry and \$5 each additional, up to 3 entries.

Hanging Requirements: Art must be dry, framed appropriately or on gallery-wrapped canvas or board, and ready to hang with wire that is not visible above the top of the picture; NO SAW TOOTH HANGERS OR CLIPS.

Size: Maximum width *and* height 36" for 2D art, including frame. One oversized entry per artist may be accepted on a case-by-case basis with \$10 oversize fee. 3D works over 20 pounds must be placed on display by artist and removed by artist.

Sales: The SWA will retain a 20% administration fee on any art sold during the show.

This year for the first time, the Fall SWA Members' Art Show will include an Artists' Bazaar table, stocked with members' Christmas-gift-worthy prints, cards and small art items. We will publicize it in area holiday bazaar lists with an aim to attract bazaar shoppers to the show. Here are the details:

ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR SALE AT THE TABLE

- Professionally printed and packaged giclées or prints. May be matted but not framed. Must be in plastic sleeves and labeled with artist, title and price. SWA will not package, label or price items.
- Professionally printed or originally painted and packaged cards either all occasion or holiday themes. Must be in plastic sleeves and labeled with artist and price.
- Professionally printed or originally painted small items such as coffee mugs, magnets, tiles, bird houses, ornaments and bags. If you are uncertain, please ask.
- Each participant may enter up to 20 items total. Each item must be labeled with artist name and price and be listed on an inventory sheet to be delivered with the items to the bazaar.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

☐ Knit, crocheted or home sewn items.

☐ Home crafts other than those specifically noted above.

Show managers reserve the right to determine whether items meet the bazaar table requirements. In addition, show managers may close the bazaar to new entries when space is filled.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS AND SALE PAYMENTS

Fees and Obligations: All participants will pay a flat \$5 fee to cover credit card processing costs. You will be billed via PayPal (separately from your show entry) or pay by check PRIOR to show opening. NO PAYMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED AT ART TAKE-IN. All participants are required to sign up to sit/sell at the bazaar table at some time during the fall show. Please go to https://volunteersignup.org/T8YX8 to reserve your time slot.

Sales: The SWA will process all sales and you will receive a check from SWA for the amount of your artwork sold. Sales checks will be available three weeks from the close of the fall show.
